






1. Who Is Streaming?

- •Big churches
- •Small churches
- Home churches
- •Bible studies
- •Schools, city councils, funeral homes
- •Simulcast events and conferences









2. What Is Streaming?

Streaming is simply a means to let people watch and/or listen to your service (or anything else!) online.

a. It can be done LIVE or on-demand

b. It is NOT downloading









3. Why Streaming?

Outreach / Broadcast – most efficient way to take your message beyond the walls of your church and around the globe.

a. In-reach / Narrowcast

b. Keep the church family connected










3. Why Streaming?

4. How Does It Work?

Do you want to stream your services LIVE, or ON DEMAND?

They target and serve different people, yet both require video to effectively reach their target.









4. How Does It Work?

What are the components you'll need?

- •Video [camera(s)] and audio
- •Computer with encoding software
- Internet connection









4. How Does It Work?

Video Cameras and Audio

- •Video set up and hardware will determine audio set up
- •Audio is usually easy to feed to the computer, camera, switcher or converter









4. How Does It Work?

Do you want to use one camera, or multiple cameras?

•Tip - Don't wait for the perfect broadcast setup to get started. Start somewhere.








How To Stream?

- •Can be flexible you set the bitrate
- •Recommend at least 750kbps upload
- Check your connection speedtest.net









How To Stream?

You'll need some good equipment.

Roland has a great line of gear:

a. VC30 – high-end converter box

b. VR5 and VR3 – audio/video mixer/switchers for streaming





How To Stream?

If you're going with a major new system, find a professional quality AV integrator. (recommendations)









How To Stream?

You'll also need "Licensing" in order to stream your worship music sets.

Two options:

- a. Church Streaming and Podcast License from CCLI
- b. WorshipCast from Christian Copyright Solutions
